Fortress Junction Services

- 5 foot scaffold to hold all ECCC meteorological instruments:
 - USask has scaffold available in shipping container at Barrier Lake
 - LiDAR (aperture 8' off ground)
 - Cannot scan downwards
 - Sight lines are good, except towards the where trees are obscuring view
 - Pluvio2 with single alter shield
 - Geonor condition is unknown
 - Parsivel1
 - MRR
 - ECCC does not have soil temperature probes
 - Stephen may purchase some
 - ECCC could easily integrate data from probes to their datalogger
 - Perhaps connect to wifi so that ECCC can remotely check on instruments

Fortress Mountain

- LiDAR at top of Fortress would be complementary to one in valley
 - Provide wind interactions at the top of the mountain
 - Good view to the south
 - Would have camera point towards LiDAR so that it can be checked remotely

Nipika

- Install Parsivel (the one working from UQAM)
- Install MRR (NCAR/ECCC?)
- John and Greg to do site visit at Nipika → empty out geonor

ECCC installation

- Instruments pre-configured in Downsview for easily installation in the field
- 2 days travel, 3 days on-site to install instruments
- 2 techs required
- ECCC to pay wage/OT for techs
- Installation sometime in April → Mike will get better idea of dates sometime in January
- Mike will need to train a couple of people on the maintenance of the instruments

 - Julie in contact with UQAM purchasing
 - o Julie to check differences between parsivel 1 and 2
- Alberta Parks permit for Fortress Service Junction
 - Juris to follow up with Greg
- ECCC shipping there and back max. \$2500
- Mike to come up with pre-installation list
 - o Install scaffold
 - Level scaffold, etc.
- Stephen to check with Nipika:
 - Groomers possibly check weather station and take pictures when they are in the area to get idea of snowpack
- Juris to mail Nipika thank you card on behalf of SPADE members
